Dutch Sonnet: Created by Leny Roovers

1. Almost an Italian sonnet 8/6 but makes a statement with a sestet, then pauses with a couplet then finishes with a sestet.
2. Rhyme Scheme: a-b-a-b-a-c-c-d-e-d-f-x-f
3. Meter: Iambic Pentameter. Syllabic: 10 syllables per line
