Carol Sonnet:

1. Four iambic pentameter triplets or four 10-syllable line triplets.
2. 14 lines from the sonnet.
3. The form combines carol and sonnet with blues stanza.
4. One rhyme throughout.
5. The final couplet is composed from 2 incremental lines A2 and A4.
6. The mono-rhyme pattern is beside the lines.
