## Converse in Couplets

Invented by John Henson

Stanza form emulates conversation in rhymed couplets.

1. Any number of rhymed couplets.
2. Syllable Count: All lines have 11 syllables.
3. Rhymed: aa- bb-cc-dd-ee-ff-gg-hh- etc.
4. Conversation between at least 2 voices.
5. One voice can be in italics.
