Tercet-tina:

1. A cooperative form in triplets repeating and rhyming end words.
2. A What's-is-tina is done with quatrains. You could do the same with longer stanzas.
3. Poets decide on three end words. They write them on the right margin.
4. For the second stanza you retain the same end words in reverse order.
5. For the third stanza you rhyme the end words of the first stanza.
6. For the fourth stanza you rhyme the end words of the second stanza. You can use the same rhyme words of the third stanza if you chose.
7. The three starting words were light, merry peach. They can be any end words you choose
8. You can add syllable count or meter if you want.. I didn't want to.
